QUALIFICATIONS:

- Communication and interpersonal skills required
- Computer skills preferred

EDUCATION/LICENSING/CERTIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED equivalent required
- BS/BA in Human Services field preferred
- Valid Alabama driver's license required and must be insurable through agency's insurance carrier

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 21 years of age or over
- Must pass a criminal, social, MVR background check, as well as obtain clearance through DHR's Child Abuse and Neglect Registry and ABI/FBI registry

Must be certified or able to pass agency required and provided training in CPR, 1st Aid, Managing Crisis Safely (MCS) and Medication Administration Certification (MAC)

- Must pass all required pre-employment screenings
