Submissions accepted July 1<sup>st</sup> – Sept. 20<sup>th</sup>

### Why submit?

Presenting a poster is an excellent opportunity to share innovative ideas, research, and clinical practices with professionals. Poster presentations allow students, practitioners, researchers, and interdisciplinary collaborators to receive feedback, engage in meaningful professional discussions, expand their network, and contribute to the dissemination of evidence-based practices.

### Who can submit?

- ✓ Students, RBTs, professionals, BCBAs, professors, teachers, special-education staff

## SUBMISSION TYPES



### RESEARCH PROPOSALS/ ONGOING RESEARCH

Present data from an ongoing research project. Purpose is to share current progress, preliminary findings, research methods, and clinical implications from a study that may still be in development



### DATA ANALYSIS

Present data from an analysis of past data. Purpose is to teach about the implications of results or connect to a current body of research



### CASE PRESENTATION

Present data from the application of behavior analytic principles and/or techniques in practice. Purpose is to discuss findings and/or collaborate on future clinical steps to take

### Adhering to ethics standards

- ✓ If submitting a data from a project that has already been approved by an IRB or RRC, submit the approval letter with your poster submission
- ✓ In general, research proposals must have IRB or RRC approval before data collection begins. If data collection occurs at university-affiliated setting, submit proposal through university IRB. Otherwise, submit to Glenwood's RRC.
- ✓ For data analysis or case presentation projects, you will need approval by an IRB or RRC to present your poster. Additional information provided by scanning QR code
